## Privacy Policy

The National Theatre, as the owner of the [narodowy.pl](http://narodowy.pl) website, is committed to protecting Users' privacy and ensuring the security of their personal data processing.

Users' personal data is processed in accordance with the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) and the Act of 18 July 2002 on the provision of electronic services (Journal of Laws of 2017, item 1219, as amended).

The personal data of Users of the [narodowy.pl](http://narodowy.pl) website, provided during the NEWSLETTER registration process (i.e. their email address), is processed by the National Theatre solely for the purposes of providing the aforementioned service.

Users have the right to access, rectify, restrict, and delete their personal data. If the User has consented to the processing of their personal data, they have the right to withdraw their consent at any time.

The controller of the personal data is the National Theatre, registered in Warsaw at Pl. Teatralny 3, 00-077, and entered into the Register of Cultural Institutions with the number RIK 48/98, under the aegis of the Minister of Culture and National Heritage, Tax Identification Number (NIP) 525-20-59-426, National Business Registry Number (REGON) 013057317.

At the National Theatre, a personal data inspector oversees compliance with all personal data processing rules. We also would like to inform you that you have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.

The processing of personal data is entrusted solely on the basis of an agreement concluded with an entity providing the Theatre with hosting services for its [narodowy.pl](http://narodowy.pl) website, i.e., home.pl Spółka Akcyjna, a joint-stock company registered at 4 Zbożowa Street, Szczecin, 70-653, and entered into the Register of Enterprises of the National Court Register, maintained by the District Court for Szczecin-Centrum in Szczecin, 13th Commercial Division of the National Court Register, with the KRS number 0000431335, registered with the Tax Identification Number (NIP) 8522103252, and National Business Registry Number (REGON) 811158242, with a share capital of PLN 1,233,400.00, fully paid up.

The period for which User data is stored depends on the type of service provided and the purpose of its processing. The storage period may be extended if processing is necessary to establish and pursue possible legal claims or defend against claims, and after that time only if and to the extent required by law.

Personal data processed based on the User's consent will be processed until the consent is withdrawn, and in cases where the legal basis for processing is the Controller's legitimate interest, until any objection to data processing is raised.

The National Theatre does not transfer, sell, or lend Users' personal data to other persons or institutions without the User's consent. Users' personal data processed by the National Theatre may be made available to authorised state authorities at their request, for the purposes of proceedings conducted by them, or to third parties based on rulings of state authorities.

The National Theatre uses cookies on the [narodowy.pl](http://narodowy.pl) website, i.e. text files saved and stored on the User's computer hard drive. The cookies are not intended to collect any individual information about the website's Users and are used only to maintain navigation parameters and gather statistical data on User traffic. Creating statistics helps us understand how Users make use of the National Theatre's website, which allows us to work on optimising it.

In addition, the National Theatre uses marketing cookies from Meta Platforms Ireland Limited (Meta Pixel) on its website, [narodowy.pl](http://narodowy.pl). These are used for: carrying out remarketing activities, measuring the effectiveness of advertising campaigns, compiling statistics on website usage, and displaying more personalised advertisements to users on Facebook and Instagram. Marketing cookies are only installed once the user has given their consent via the cookie banner. The user may change their cookie preferences or withdraw their consent at any time.

Users may delete cookies from their computer hard drive or change their settings in their web browser at any time. Deleting or changing cookie settings in their browser may cause problems with the use of the [narodowy.pl](http://narodowy.pl) website.

The website contains links to other websites. The National Theatre is not responsible for the privacy practices of these websites.

By using the [narodowy.pl](http://narodowy.pl) website, in any way at all, users accept the terms and conditions set forth in this Privacy Policy.

## Cookies Policy

The National Theatre, located at Pl. Teatralny 3, Warsaw 00-077, in accordance with its obligations under Article 173 of the Telecommunications Law of 16 July 2004 (Journal of Laws No. 171, item 1800, as amended), hereby provides the information below on the use of cookies by the National Theatre.

The National Theatre uses cookies on its [narodowy.pl](http://narodowy.pl) website (hereinafter the "Website").

The legal basis for processing personal data in connection with the use of necessary cookies is due to the necessity to process data for the performance of a contract (Article 6, paragraph 1, letter (b) of the GDPR).

The legal basis for processing personal data in connection with the use of functional, analytical, and marketing cookies is due to the legitimate interest of the Controller (Article 6, paragraph 1, letter (f) of the GDPR), which consists in ensuring the highest quality of the services provided. The processing of personal data in connection with the use of functional and analytical cookies is dependent on obtaining the User's consent to the use of functional and analytical cookies, said consent being expressed through the configuration of the web browser used by the User.

Cookies are information files that are stored on the device of a User visiting/using a given website, including the website operated by the National Theatre. Cookies are saved on the User's device by the web browser when the User first accesses the website. By storing cookies on the User's device, each time the User connects to a given website, the website can determine that the User has previously used the website and can tailor its content to the User.

The National Theatre uses cookies for the following purposes:

- a) to adapt the content of the website's pages to the User's preferences and to optimise the use of the website; in particular, these files allow the website to recognise the device of the User and properly display the website, tailored to their individual needs.
- b) to create statistics that help understand how Users use the website, which allows for the improvement of its structure and content.
- c) to maintain the User's session (after logging in), which allows the User, for example, to avoid having to re-enter their login and password on each subpage.

The National Theatre hereby declares that cookies used by the Website do not allow for the identification and storage of User's personal data.

The National Theatre also would like to state that using its Website without changing cookie settings constitutes consent to the storage of these files in the memory of the device used by the User to access the Website. Each time the User reconnects to the Website using a device used to access the National Theatre Website, they will be able to access previously saved cookies.

Each User has the option of changing the way cookies are used that originate from, or are used by, the National Theatre. It is also possible to delete or block such cookies.

To change the way cookies are used, or to block or delete them, please make the appropriate changes in your web browser settings. Detailed information on how cookies are handled should be available in the settings of individual web browsers.

The National Theatre uses the following cookies on its website:

- a) "essential" cookies, enabling the full use of the services available on the website.
- b) cookies used to ensure security, e.g. to detect authentication abuses on the website.
- c) cookies that enable the collection of information about how the website's pages are used, e.g. how much time is spent on a specific subpage or the number of visits.
- d) "functional" cookies, enabling the "remembering" of settings selected by the User and the personalisation of the User interface, e.g. in terms of the selected language or the User's region, font size, website appearance, etc.
- e) Google Analytics cookies are cookies used by Google to analyse how the website is used by the User, to create statistics and reports on website performance. Google Analytics uses information such as: information about the operating system and web browser used by the User, the subpages viewed within the website, the time spent browsing the website and its subpages, transitions between subpages, and the source from which the User accessed the website. Users' personal data may be transferred outside the EEA due to Google Ireland Limited entrusting data to Google Limited Liability Company on servers located, among other places, in the USA. The basis for the transfer of personal data to the USA is the "EU-US Data Protection Framework." You have the option to opt out of the transfer of your data for analytical and statistical purposes using Google Analytics.
